Footnotes

HOLYCOW SHES SASSY raced unhurried off the second flight between foes in the opening half, continued under patient handling into the second bend, split foes three wide nearing upper stretch when presented an opening and responded to firm handling to wrest command and draw clear. DYNAMICFLOWER stalked just off the leaders three deep racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue in that path racing through the far turn, edged forward to a narrow advantage near midstretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. AMERICAN SONATA tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight in the opening half, made some progress to challenge four wide racing through the far turn but lacked the needed final bid. PLEASANTLYBDANCING joined the pace outside a rival racing into the backstretch, pressed between foes into the far turn to upper stretch and weakened in the closing stages. LITTLE MARY E, reserved off the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, couldn't produce the needed closing bid. CALAMITY CODE, reserved behind the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, never gained contention. FRENCH CHICK settled outside foes in the opening stages, was caught five wide racing through the far turn and soon proved empty. DON'T CRY A TEAR was urged to dispute the pace along the inside racing into the backstretch, dueled into the second bend and emptied out nearing upper stretch.
