KIND REGARDS joined a rival's pace in the opening stages attending the tempo, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch, then kicked clear and opened a clear margin in the last furlong under firm right handed encouragement. LUCK WITH A KISS stumbled at the start, was quickly righted to stalk just off the leaders three deep racing into the bend, moved to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but prevailed for second. CAPT. BULLET BOB was urged to dispute the pace from the outset while shifting off the inside, dueled into upper stretch and weakened in late stages. SACRED GIFT tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing to the bend, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and continued willingly to late stages. FOUR LEFT FEET delayed proceedings when requiring a shoe repair in the paddock, was reserved off the second flight outside a rival in early stages, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. HAMMERS BULLET tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight early, was caught four wide racing into the turn and lacked a closing response. MISFIRED, a bit slow into stride, shifted to the inside early and never menaced thereafter. ALL TANKED UP, pulling hard just off the inside racing as part of the second flight in the opening quarter, continued nearest the inside on the turn and came up empty nearing upper stretch.
