Footnotes

TANK'S LETTER broke sharply, was held up just outside the leaders in the opening quarter, advanced readily to challenge three deep after a half, wrested command in upper stretch and went clear under firm encouragement. CHEROKEE WARPAINT tracked the leaders unhurried inside foes as part of the second flight in the opening stages, swung out four wide to race between foes into upper stretch, couldn't menace the winner but prevailed for second late. COLORADO TRAIL was urged to dispute the pace along the rail, relinquished the lead to a rival after the opening quarter, shifted out to bid between foes nearing upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the winner in the last furlong. RIVER OF NO RETURN, a bit slow into stride, angled to the inside, saved ground on the turn, shifted out to spit foes in upper stretch and improved his placing to the end. SHARP TRICK settled outside foes in the opening quarter, swung five wide racing into upper stretch while drawing into contention but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. LIQUIDATION tracked the pace between foes in second flight, angled to the inside on the turn but steadily faded in upper stretch. CLOUD CASTLE, reserved outside foes racing to the bend, never gained striking distance. CRAFTY CAPE was hustled to the lead outside a rival, opened a clear advantage on the bend but gave way abruptly after a half. CAPTAIN WOOD was never a factor. JIMMY'S IMAGE angled inwards to track outside foes in the second flight but dropped out after a half.
