Footnotes

MAGNA FORTUNA sped to the fore while angling to the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin to the second bend, was urged to maintain the advantage racing into upper stretch and held sway on a widening margin to the end while being kept to pressure. SIR BOB, forwardly placed tracking just off the pacesetter in the opening half, was urged along in pursuit of the leader racing through the far turn, but couldn't gain terms with that foe while proving best of the others. VIA DELOROSA, reserved in last along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out four wide racing through the far turn while being prompted to advance and continued with an effort to improve position while earning a share. EIGHT GAUGE, held up off the second flight between foes racing into the backstretch, offered no closing bid. CAPTAIN AMERICAN, reserved off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, lacked the needed closing response. MISTER PADDY tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages and emptied out racing through the far turn. KING FEST was a brief factor inside foes in the second flight but retreated from contention early.
