Footnotes

STATIC KILL took up a position stalking just off the pacesetter under rating in the opening stages, continued with a steady bid to wrest command leaving the midway point of the bend, shifted to the rail in upper stretch and continued with a solid late response to maintain the advantage to the end under firm right handed encouragement. KELLY LEAK tracked the leaders from just out of striking racing three deep to the bend, continued in that path on the turn while making a steady advance to challenge nearing upper stretch, closed the gap nearing midstretch but couldn't gain even terms with the winner. RIVERSHIRE tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, steadily drew into contention on the bend, shifted out four deep in upper stretch and continued willingly while earning a share. ROARIN MISSILE tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside racing into the turn but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. HOT DAMON hopped at the start, settled into stride in last along the inside racing to the turn and never gained contention. CODE OF KINGS was urged to the lead along the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn and emptied out after a half.
