PLEASANT CLOSING, in touch with the leaders while nearest the rail racing into the first turn, was eased off the leaders to track those foes along the inside as part of the second flight racing to the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch, then came through inside foes nearing the furlong marker to challenge for command, wresting the advantage and edging forward in time under firm right handed encouragement. DAKOTA DIGGER, off a step behind the leaders, was urged to gain a tracking position racing three deep in the second flight, continued in that position to the second bend, made steady progress to challenge the leaders in that path racing into upper stretch, struck the front between calls late but couldn't contain the winner's bid. GOOD CHEMISTRY joined the pace between foes racing into the first turn, shifted to the inside entering the backstretch, dueled for command inside a rival on the second bend while shifting a bit off the rail entering upper stretch, then continued with a grudging effort between foes to the end while just failing to contain the top pair. ZOEBEAR joined the pace three deep in the opening stages, continued to force the issue outside a rival racing through the backstretch into the far turn, pressed between foes into upper stretch but weakened leaving the furlong marker. PEDROLINO settled off the second flight racing a bit off the inside in the opening half and never gained striking position. KING ROOTIN TOOTIN, pulling inside foes in the second flight while a bit rank racing through the first turn, was taken back to track off the second flight entering the backstretch, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch while being roused to advance but couldn't make a serious impression on the leaders. MCLARD tracked just off the first flight between foes under light rating in the opening stages, continued in that position into the second bend and emptied out racing into upper stretch. STAR OF PARADISE, reserved in last near the inside racing to the backstretch, never gained contention.
