ZAVATA'S GOLD sped to the lead in the opening furlong remaining a bit off the inside, attended a rival's pace under light rating racing into the turn, edged clear nearing upper stretch, held sway past the furlong marker and drifted to the rail in the final sixteenth while being kept to firm encouragement. WILDWOOD PERFECT shifted inwards at the start, was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival after the opening furlong racing into the bend, continued along the inside to upper stretch while losing some ground to that foe, then switched out in late stages while continuing with interest to the end. IOLANDA'S PERFECT settled out of striking distance along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch and found his best stride late to close the gap while prevailing for a share. MR NUM NUM tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and continued with a mild bid while being outkicked for a share. NEXTALAST tracked off the second flight in the opening stages, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch while being urged to advance but lacked the needed final kick. PAINTED ROCK briefly tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight racing to the turn but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. VALID DEVIL trailed throughout.
