Footnotes

ITZACOLDCASE, in close attendance to the pace from the outset racing in hand while three deep in the opening stages, steadily moved to challenge the pacesetter in that path racing into upper stretch in tandem with EURONFIRE, then edged clear of that foe in the last furlong under firm encouragement. The latter broke inwards brushing COWGIRL KNOCKOUT, was held up just off that foe to stalk the pace along the inside racing into the bend, came through when presented an opening to challenge for command inside the pacesetter in upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the winner in the last furlong. ABUELA EMMA, caught five deep in the opening stages tracking just off the first flight, continued with a steady effort to challenge four wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. RANSOM ZIP broke slowly then was bumped at the start, shifted outside foes to race widest into the turn, swung six wide entering upper stretch, then shifted inwards under pressure in the closing stages while making an effort to improve position. COWGIRL KNOCKOUT, brushed at the start, was urged to secure the lead inside foes racing through the backstretch, set the pace into upper stretch while shifting off the inside and emptied out nearing the furlong marker. LOCK N LOLA was urged to join the pace between foes from the outset but retreated from striking distance early. BELLA ROAD was a brief factor four deep between foes tracking just off the first flight but was through after a half. SAMARA STREET broke outwards bumping RANSOM ZIP, was guided nearer to the inside tracking the leaders from out of striking distance but lacked a closing response.
