Footnotes

I'M OLD SCHOOL broke sharply to dictate the pace along the inside while racing on his own courage, forged clear racing into upper stretch and extended the advantage under pressure. SMOKEM GRAY tracked the leaders outside a rival early from out of striking distance racing to the turn, was fanned four wide racing through upper stretch and continued with interest to edge a rival for the place honors late. BATTLE FACTS was urged to terms with the eventual winner on the backstretch prompting that foe's pace, proved no match after a half and steadily weakened in the drive. DELUX DEELITE was rated tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance in the opening stages, shifted out three wide entering the lane while being urged to advance but had no late response. HOTPEPPER PLEASE, reserved in the opening stages, drifted out making contact with SILVER PRINCE near the half mile marker and never gained contention. SILVER PRINCE settled outside foes early, was jostled racing through the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge.
