Footnotes

TELLME ALL ABOUTIT broke outwards, was quickly collected and guided to the inside while maintaining striking distance just inside the pacesetter racing into the bend, bid for command inside that foe entering upper stretch, wrested command and made the balance of the pace under firm handling. DAZZLIN DAY broke readily, tracked just off the first flight racing to the turn, advanced to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, couldn't match the winner's kick nearing the furlong marker but continued willingly to close the gap on that foe to the end. TATY'S GOLD shied outwards at the start, was quickly righted, then sped clear setting the pace a bit off the inside, held sway into upper stretch but faltered approaching the furlong marker. PREMIUM CUT broke last, tracked the leaders unhurried outside a rival racing to the bend, angled to the rail in late stages and just missed for a share. SWEET CHI TOWN, a bit outpaced in early stages, switched outside foes racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. AIR STRIPE tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance along the inside racing into the bend, was caught in tight quarters entering the turn and quickly faded from contention.
