LAKEAWAY, reserved in hand near the inside in the opening half, switched out three wide entering the far turn commencing a steady advance, made solid progress in that path racing into upper stretch to wrest command leaving the furlong marker, pulled clear under hand urging and was taken in hand once the issue was decided. CATALINA WAY sped to the fore along the rail racing into the first turn, moved clear after a half, set the pace on a comfortable margin to upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner. PRAIRIE ACADEMY broke outwards bumping RUN MAMA BEARE RUN, was quickly righted to gain a tracking position just off the leaders, continued to track the pacesetter into the second bend but offered no closing bid when urged to challenge nearing upper stretch. DUBIOUS was settled outside a rival in the opening half, then came around some tiring rivals racing into the stretch. RUN MAMA BEARE RUN, bumped at the start and forced into OFOUROONEOFIVE, was urged to secure a forward placing outside a rival, couldn't match that foe racing through the backstretch and steadily retreated on the far turn. OFOUROONEOFIVE, bumped at the start, angled to the inside early tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance in the opening half but steadily faded from contention racing through the far turn.
