BIG BRUIN was held up tracking the first flight from just out of striking distance racing a bit off the inside in the opening half, steadily drew into contention while shifting out three deep nearing upper stretch, was roused to wrest command approaching the furlong marker, shifted inwards under pressure but held sway to the end under firm handling. BOBBY SANDS, reserved along the inside racing into the backstretch, gradually drew into contention on the second bend while shifting out four wide nearing upper stretch, couldn't match the winner's kick but continued with interest to edge a rival for second late. CHAMPION KID sped to the fore along the inside to set the pace on a narrow margin racing to the backstretch, ceded the lead after three furlongs to attend a rival's pace through the backstretch, was urged to dispute the issue inside that foe racing through the far turn, struck the front between calls nearing midstretch but weakened once headed by the winner. MASTMAN bobbed at the break, was quickly righted, then urged to join a rival on the lead racing into the first turn, forced the issue into the backstretch to gain a narrow advantage after a half, continued to press the issue outside that foe through the far turn but weakened between foes leaving midstretch. INSTILL, reserved in last while shifting a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, angled out five wide racing into the stretch but never menaced and lost contact with the field when finishing in hand in the final sixteenth.
