WILD HOPE, in touch with the leaders between foes while unhurried in the opening quarter, shifted out three deep leaving the turn commencing her challenge, then reeled in STEALTH WOMAN in the final stages to prevail under firm handling. The latter, prominent between foes from the outset, relinquished the lead to a rival while angling to the inside entering the bend, moved to regain command inside that foe in upper stretch, drew away to a clear advantage leaving the furlong marker but just failed to contain the winner. SHOPPING CART, caught in close quarters and held up just after the start, tracked the leaders off the inside early, was pushed out a bit near the half mile marker, continued with interest off the inside to upper stretch, split foes racing through the lane and made some belated progress for a share. OUR CHARMER was urged to join the pace racing four wide on the backstretch, angled inwards to briefly wrest command on the bend but gave way once headed in upper stretch. PRINCESS OF POWER, held up just off the inside in early stages, shifted out sharply leaving the half mile marker, lodged a brief, four wide bid leaving the bend but quickly flattened out. EVE'S APPLE, off slowly, was urged to gain contention racing inside foes nearing the bend but soon came up empty. LADY LEPRECHAUN, close up between foes in the opening quarter, was shuffled back in traffic entering the turn and soon gave way.
