Footnotes

DISTORTED GROOM was urged to the fore in the opening furlong, dictated the pace along the rail racing into the bend, then held sway to the end, maintaining a clear advantage while being kept to the task. CURE, bumped by FORT APACHE at the start, was settled into stride along the inside, gathered momentum on the bend, swung out five wide in upper stretch and made steady progress to the end to secure the place. EL MEDWAR tracked the pacesetter along the inside early, saved ground to upper stretch while moving into striking distance but finished evenly in late stages. OATMAN tracked the pacesetter racing three wide in second, and began a steady fade racing into upper stretch. FIELDSTONE tracked the pacesetter between foes in second flight racing into the bend and came up empty after a half. FORT APACHE broke in, bumped CURE and soon dropped out.
