Footnotes

DA SNOOP, reserved along the inside for a half, angled off the rail gathering momentum leaving the far turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and just collared TERRIFIC TIM to prevail in time. The latter went up from the break to force the pace outside a rival racing into the backstretch, shook clear after a half, resisted several challenges racing along the rail through the stretch and narrowly missed. LOYAL LIGHTFOOT, held up out of tight quarters at the start, was reserved along the inside to the backstretch, shifted out making steady progress three deep in upper stretch but was outfinished by the top pair. JINGLE JANGLE worked his way to the inside in early stages, made steady progress racing into upper stretch to briefly menace the pacesetter but flattened out in the drive. SPECIAL SIX was settled off the inside racing to the backstretch and passed some tiring rivals in the drive. LOLEK was settled off the inside early but never gained contention. WINDY CITY LEAL briefly disputed the pace along the inside racing to the backstretch, then gave way on the far turn. LANDING CHASER, carried out a bit racing through the first turn, continued three deep on the backstretch, then emptied out racing through the far turn. CASA SACA drifted out impeding a rival racing into the first turn, continued a bit erratically as a result of some broken equipment, was pulled up on the far turn, then walked off the course under his own power.
