SUSPENDED MOON was urged to gain a position three deep in the second flight racing into the backstretch, tracked just off the pacesetter in that path to the second bend, steadily moved to force the issue racing through the far turn, wrested command in upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm right handed encouragement. DIRECT BREEZE was settled off the second flight racing to the backstretch, swung out four wide racing into upper stretch and made steady progress in late stages to close the gap while prevailing for place honors. DAZZLE HER was rated just off the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out to the three path entering upper stretch while being urged to advance but lacked the needed final kick. PRINCIPALIA settled off the field along the inside in the opening half, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. BOB'S HILDA, a bit unruly in the gate before the start, was urged to secure the lead racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the inside into the second bend, couldn't contain the winner's bid after six furlongs and quickly emptied out. PASSPOST TO PARIS ducked inwards a bit at the start, gained a position between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch while under some reserve but steadily faded racing through the far turn.
