FUN ON THE BAYOU was settled just out of striking position tracking the first flight outside a rival racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady, three wide advance midway through the far turn to challenge the pacesetter nearing midstretch, wrested command from that foe and drew clear late under firm right handed encouragement. PRICELESS SHORE, held up just off the leaders three deep in the opening stages, moved to command nearing the half mile marker, shifted to the inside on the second bend to set the pace into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner's bid but continued with interest to save the place honors. DEFIANT FLYER, in touch with the pacesetter stalking just off that foe under light rating in the opening stages, continued unhurried between foes racing into the second bend, was urged to advance in tandem with the eventual winner while moving to challenge between foes racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. HE'S GOT TO RUN was steadied a bit along the rail racing into the first turn while tracking just off the pacesetter, continued along the inside under light reserve into the backstretch, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed closing response. PREOCCUPIED moved to the fore while shifting to the rail in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin for a half, was urged along once headed nearing the second bend but quickly gave way. SECURE, a bit rank under restraint tracking the leaders between foes into the first turn, shifted to the inside nearing the backstretch while settling in last and couldn't produce a closing response.
