Footnotes

INDYGO KISS shifted inwards racing to the first turn while taking up a position just off the second flight tracking the pace, made steady progress three deep on the far turn to challenge for command racing into upper stretch, gained the advantage and moved clear late under firm handling. SUMMER AGAIN sped to the fore near the inside, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin into the far turn, briefly resisted the winner's challenge and proved best of the others. SCARLET POWER, forwardly placed tracking just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, was urged to challenge between foes nearing upper stretch but weakened nearing the furlong marker. LEWDERHOO, a bit restless in the gate, settled between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, gathered some momentum splitting foes leaving the far turn, angled four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with an effort to improve position. CALL ME CLASSY tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside racing into the far turn, shifted out racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. COYOTE BREEZE stalked just off the pacesetter between foes in the opening half but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. BLOOMING FLOWER, caught five wide racing into the first turn while dropping off the second flight, continued widest through the far turn and steadily retreated. LOST FRIEND settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. LIME TRYST worked her way to the inside tracking off the second flight in the opening half but offered no closing bid. GLORIOUS DESTINY showed little.
