Footnotes

FRANK'S TIME was held up saving ground tracking just off the first flight in the opening half, shifted out a bit awaiting an opening on the far turn, came around a tiring foe to challenge along the rail in upper stretch and prevailed in the final stages under brisk handling. ECONOMIC BAILOUT, in close attendance to the pace while racing three wide to the backstretch, continued in that path pressing the issue into the stretch, continued gamely to the end and was just outfinished. ALL IN SLEW was urged to the fore from the break, prompted the pace outside a rival racing to the far turn, dueled between foes into upper stretch and couldn't quite match the top pair late. DUNSCOMBE, a bit slow into stride, tracked just off the leaders to the backstretch, angled four wide on the backstretch, lodged a brief bid in that path entering the far turn and flattened out nearing midstretch. HOLY CITY secured a forward placing along the rail racing to the backstretch, attended a rival's pace in hand for a half but came up empty when called upon to press that rival.
