Footnotes

SASSY BUCK, brushed at the start, was held up outside foes in the opening stages, shifted out four wide on the backstretch while gaining terms with the first flight after a half, continued to press three deep entering the far turn, then edged away to a clear advantage while being kept to steady pressure. UMMA UMMA, forwardly placed in the opening stages racing three deep into the bend, was reserved off the leaders while angling to the rail entering the backstretch, continued under some reserve to the far turn, shifted off the rail to race three deep in upper stretch and continued with interest to secure the place. MARY ABBOTT, held up racing along the inside in early stages, shifted out three deep to bid between foes after a half, disputed the issue inside the winner to midstretch but proved no match late. HANNA FOM SAVANAH broke out, brushed SASSY BUCK, was settled into stride, angled out five deep nearing upper stretch and made some belated progress. LIEM'S LUCK, prominent along the rail from the outset, relinquished the lead entering the backstretch to track just off the first flight to the far turn but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. D' CODE angled inwards to disputed the pace inside foes racing into the backstretch, dueled into the far turn and gave way entering upper stretch.
