Footnotes

KUNA, reserved in hand outside foes from just out of striking distance in the opening quarter, made a steady advance on the leaders racing three wide through the bend, drew on terms with the pacesetter leaving midstretch and edged that rival late under firm right handed encouragement. NEXT ADVENTURE ducked out, bumped DOUGHNUT MAN, was collected off that foe to race under reserve along the rail, saved ground to upper stretch, found his best stride late to challenge inside the pacesetter and was narrowly outfinished. DOUGHNUT MAN, bumped at the start, quickly recovered, sprinted to the lead along the inside, dueled inside a rival into upper stretch, resisted that challenger to maintain a narrow advantage past the furlong marker but couldn't contain the top pair late. ICANDAZZLE was held up tracking just off the leaders in the opening stages, lost some ground to the leaders on the bend, shifted out to split foes three wide in upper stretch and continued willingly to the end. ROYALNREGAL DREAMS broke outwards hitting the gate, then threw his head after the start, tracked outside foes unhurried to the bend, lodged a brief, four wide bid on the bend but steadily faded in the drive. DEW DETIME angled inwards to prompt the pace outside a rival racing into the bend, then gave way leaving midstretch.
