Footnotes

MILES AND MILES, forwardly placed between foes racing into the first turn, was eased off the leaders to track those foes under rating to the second bend, moved to challenge three wide leaving the far turn and narrowly prevailed under firm encouragement. FIRST TO KNOW, urged to a forward placing four deep racing into the first turn, pressed the issue three deep entering the second bend, continued willingly between foes into upper stretch and resisted the winner to the end. KERA'S KITTEN was urged to secure the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, then resisted the top pair grudgingly to the end in a prolonged drive. PEYTONVILLE settled off the leaders near the inside racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. ELECTRIC ALPHABET joined the pace three deep between foes racing to the backstretch, continued to dispute the issue into the second bend and steadily weakened nearing upper stretch. GUADALCANAL was never a factor.
