MONKEY WENCH broke sharply to dictate the pace outside a rival on a narrow margin while on her own courage in the opening stages, shifted to the rail once gaining a clear advantage between calls entering the bend and continued with a steady response to prove best under firm handling. ZUNI WOMEN hopped a bit at the start, was urged to gain a position just off the first flight racing into the bend, was urged to challenge the leader nearing upper stretch but couldn't gain even terms with that foe while proving clearly best of the others. PYLORTES, urged to dispute the pace inside the eventual winner, shifted out racing into the stretch but steadily faded from contention. VERY LUCKY STAR broke slowly, angled to the inside racing into the turn and made an effort to improve position while never making an impression on the leaders. ANGEL MY ANGEL was a brief factor racing four wide in the opening quarter but retreated from contention early. EL SANRICH broke awkwardly and trailed the field to the stretch.
