Footnotes

TORO GRANDE ducked in at the start, was quickly righted to stalk just off the pacesetter along the rail racing into the turn, steadily drew into striking position racing nearest the rail in upper stretch, then shifted out of tight quarters nearing the furlong marker and produced a steady late response to narrowly edge LUCK WITH A KISS under firm right handed encouragement. The latter veered outwards at the start momentarily impeding ULTIMATE X. and ROSSCAT, was urged to secure the lead while shifting nearer to the inside, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin to upper stretch, resisted the winner's bid to the end while shifting out a bit in late stages but came up second best. ULTIMATE X., forced into the path of ROSSCAT at the start, was righted while shifting out on the backstretch to track off the second flight racing into the bend, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid while gaining a share late. MAGIC MAN settled outside foes in the last flight in the opening quarter, angled five wide racing through upper stretch and made some mild progress to close the gap in that path. HINKSON CREEK broke readily, tracked just off the pacesetter outside a rival racing into the bend, lodged a brief, three wide bid entering upper stretch but quickly faded from contention. ROSSCAT, shuffled out of tight quarters at the start, angled to the inside racing through the turn while racing well off the second flight and had no closing response.
