**Footnotes**

PRINCE WHO was rated outside foes in the opening stages while gaining a position just off the first flight, was urged to advance four deep entering the bend, forged clear nearing upper stretch and extended the margin to the end under pressure. HIGHFLYINGBLESSING was guided well to the outside in the opening stages dropping well off the leaders, continued five wide on the bend to upper stretch, then continued in that path while finding his best stride late to gain the place honors nearing the wire. CHANTILLY OUTLAW broke inwards crossing the path of TRY A LEMON DROP, was urged to force the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, couldn't match the winner's bid after a half and weakened through the stretch to lose second nearing the wire. I'M OLD SCHOOL was urged to press the pace along the rail in the opening quarter, saved ground on the turn while dropping off the leaders and steadily faded in late stages. RICHARD'S TUNE broke outwards impeding TRY A LEMON DROP, shifted out in the opening stages while being prompted to advance on the first flight three deep between racing into the turn but emptied out racing into upper stretch. PAPASOTE, held up just off the first flight four deep between foes in the opening quarter, continued outside foes on the turn and had no closing response. TRY A LEMON DROP, cut off at the start, never gained contention. HAPPY COOPER, urged along between foes in the opening stages, shifted in sharply nearing the half mile marker while striking the rail, then fell losing his rider and was subsequently vanned off the course. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
