Footnotes

AKA LILY'S LAD sped to the lead along the rail into the backstretch, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin to the second bend, turned back challenges from several rivals racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. SACRED GROUND tracked just off the pacesetter while unhurried racing along the rail into the backstretch, saved ground on the second bend awaiting an opening, shifted out sharply nearing midstretch while brushing PUBLISH to challenge between foes, but couldn't gain terms with the winner while proving best of the others. PUBLISH, exchanged some light contact with EMBALO (BRZ) at the start, raced unhurried along the inside in the opening quarter racing just out of striking distance, shifted outside foes on the backstretch, advanced to contention three deep racing into the far turn, couldn't match terms with the winner leaving the quarter mile marker, was brushed approaching the furlong marker by SACRED GROUND and quickly flattened out. SUMMER'S EMPIRE, reserved outside a rival in the opening half, raced four wide into upper stretch but never gained striking distance. EMBALO (BRZ) exchanged some contact with PUBLISH at the start, was quickly righted to stalk just outside the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid between foes on the second bend but emptied out in upper stretch.
