Footnotes

PRETTY CHAMP, brushed at the start, was urged to the lead outside foes, angled to the inside once clear after the opening furlong, set the pace on a clear margin into upper stretch and held sway to the end under strong handling. OH GEE SHE'S GOLD, forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter outside a rival racing into the turn, couldn't close the gap on the winner but proved best of the others. I WANT OUT, forwardly placed along the rail from the break, chased the pacesetter inside a rival into upper stretch and steadily weakened racing through the lane. MODESTA tracked off the second flight while shifting to the outside in the opening stages, then raced four wide into the stretch while making an even effort. REAL OBVIOUS broke a step slowly then was caught in tight quarters at the start, recovered to make brief progress between foes racing through the turn but lacked the needed final kick. MYSTERY RIDGE was a brief factor along the inside racing as part of the second flight but steadily faded from contention on the turn while nearest the rail. FLYING DOLLY broke awkwardly while shifting into the path of the eventual winner, was taken in hand and never gained contention. CANDY PASS was under pressure to contend outside foes in the second flight early, angled inwards entering the turn and soon gave way.
