WAY SIDEINN sped to the fore inside foes to gain a narrow advantage in the opening sixteenth, dictated the pace a bit off the inside racing into the turn, continued off the inside to upper stretch, exchanged some contact with SARA'S GOLDMINE near the three sixteenths marker and again leaving the furlong pole but narrowly prevailed under firm handling. SARA'S GOLDMINE gained terms with a rival on the pace attended the tempo between foes soon after the start, pressed the issue nearing upper stretch, exchanged some light contact with the winner racing through the stretch and was just outfinished. FLOR MORENA, in close attendance to the pace three deep from the outset, continued with a steady bid in that path racing into upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. J'S HONOR shifted outwards at the start, was quickly corrected to gain a position just off the pacesetter along the rail, made a brief bid nearest the inside when presented an opening in upper stretch, then switched out four deep in late stages while failing to gain terms with the first flight. SIX SIXTY broke sharply, was eased off the pace in the opening furlong and never menaced thereafter.
