Footnotes

I WANT OUT joined the pace outside a rival racing well off the inside in the opening stages, shifted in entering the bend to force the issue outside a rival, dueled for command into upper stretch, edged forward leaving the furlong marker and held safe the challenge of SPACE OF TIME under firm right handed encouragement. The latter tracked off the second flight along the rail in the opening stages, steadily advanced to contention switching off the inside on the turn, shifted four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady response to close the gap late. BALLYGAWLEY was urged to dispute the pace from the outset while shifting to the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. SWEETPRINCESSCHARM, urged along inside foes racing in second flight in pursuit of the leaders, shifted out three wide racing through the stretch and finished evenly in the last furlong. CAMAGIN, reserved in hand dropping into last while angling inwards a bit in the opening stages, shifted to the rail nearing the bend, was roused to advance along the inside racing into the stretch but made no impression on the leaders. BETTER SAFE broke outwards bumping SPEEDY BULLET at the start, was righted to track the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the bend but retreated from contention early. SPEEDY BULLET, bumped at the start, raced four wide just off the second flight into the turn and soon faded from contention.
