HOLD THAT BROAD joined the pace outside foes from the outset, moved to press the issue outside a rival racing into the turn, shook clear in upper stretch, then drifted out in the final furlong while responding to firm right handed pressure to contain the challenge of MIGHTY RULE to the end. The latter was urged to contend along the rail in the opening stages, steadied a bit avoiding close quarters nearing the turn, shifted out on the turn while steadily moving to striking position, was bumped by SUMO entering upper stretch, then was fanned seven wide in late stages while moving to terms with the winner but came up second best. SUMO raced in close quarters between foes as part of the second flight tracking the leaders, drifted out entering upper stretch making some contact with MIGHTY RULE and finished evenly in the four path while earning a share. DEVIENT BEHAVIOR, off last, was urged through close quarters in the opening furlong to secure the lead from between foes, dueled inside a rival on the turn and gave way near midstretch when proving no match. ROARIN MISSILE vied for command between foes near the inside racing into the bend and steadily faded along the rail in late stages. MEADOW MAGIC, held up just off the leaders when caught in tight quarters racing through the backstretch, never mounted a serious challenge. UNO PECADOR, dropped well off the pace and never menaced thereafter.
