ENERGY WARNING broke sharply, angled inwards to gain terms with a rival on the lead, forced the pace outside that foe on the bend to gain a narrow advantage after a half, shook clear in upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. GREYHAWK bobbled at the start, was collected to track off the second flight racing to the turn, swung out four wide gaining striking position after a half, couldn't gain terms with the winner but prevailed for place honors. IDEAL ALLUVIAL was held up just off the first flight between foes in the opening stages, split foes entering upper stretch to challenge inside the pacesetter but lacked the needed final kick. WICKED LOVER secured position three deep in the second flight in the opening quarter, made a brief bid in that path nearing upper stretch but flattened out racing between foes leaving midstretch. WRIGLEYVILLE was urged to position in the second flight along the rail in the opening quarter, was eased back while shifting out on the turn but offered no closing response. CANDY VAN CAN was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival from the break, dueled for command into the turn and gave way after a half. HIP HOPPER settled off the inside in the opening stages and never gained contention. THOR'S SWORD was soon outpaced.
