Footnotes

HOLY GERI rated just off the leaders along the inside in the opening half, shifted out three wide entering the second bend while readily advancing on the top pair under her own courage, assumed command and widened her margin through the stretch under pressure. TARVA tracked the pace three wide racing off the second flight, made a steady effort in that path to gain second nearing midstretch and held a rival for place honors. SASSY BUCK raced unhurried between foes in the last flight in the opening half, advanced to contention between foes on the second bend, shifted out of close quarters nearing midstretch and continued evenly to gain a share. SIN BIN settled along the inside in the opening stages, angled out four wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. SURELY JACKSON, forwardly placed along the inside from the break, shifted outside a rival entering the first turn, pressed that foe racing into the second bend and gave way nearing upper stretch. SAGEDUST was urged to the lead while angling to the rail racing to the first turn, disputed the lead inside a rival into the far turn and gave way. WILD ABOUT BOYS was a brief factor outside foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch but was through after a half.
