Footnotes

GRATTAN STREET tracked the pacesetter from striking distance racing just off the inside into the backstretch, readily advanced to press for command entering the far turn, continued in an extended skirmish into upper stretch and edged forward late under firm encouragement. FRANK'S CHOICE sped clear of the field while angling sharply to the rail, set the pace to the far turn, resisted the winner when challenged to late stages but proved only second best. TOCET ROCKET settled in hand three deep racing well off the second flight, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and made some progress to secure a share. SMOKY STORM tracked off the second flight along the inside, shifted out to split foes racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. LOYAL LIGHTFOOT settled well off the pace in the opening half, swung seven wide racing into the stretch and made some belated progress. TALK IT OUT, reserved in hand in the opening stages racing in the last flight, split foes three wide racing into upper stretch to gain some position while making little impact. FEAR NOR FAVOR tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight, made a brief advance three deep on the second bend but couldn't produce a closing bid. POOR JOHN settled between foes in the opening stages and never gained striking distance. PARTY KING stumbled at the start, was

collected to track the pace four wide in second flight racing to the far turn but steadily retreated in the drive. LUCKY PINS was a brief factor inside foes in the second flight but dropped out early. PROTECTION GAME tracked the leaders three wide in the second flight and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. BIG PRETTY settled off the second flight near the inside early, switched out to make a brief bid racing into upper stretch, was pulled up leaving the furlong marker and vanned off the course.
