Footnotes

DANCING DOVE broke slowly, steadily gathered momentum splitting foes racing into the turn while moving to regain contention, shifted out three deep racing into upper stretch to challenge for command, then wrested the advantage and drew clear late under firm encouragement. DUSTEM CAROLINA was urged to terms with the pacesetter in the second furlong to force the pace between foes racing into the turn, dueled inside a rival racing into upper stretch, continued willingly to late stages but was no match for the winner. SWIFT CLOSER settled outside foes tracking off the second flight racing to the turn, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with an effort to improve position. SEELY ROSE was rated tracking off the first flight outside a rival in the opening quarter, shifted out entering the bend, was fanned four wide between foes racing into upper stretch but had no closing response. KATY'S CHARM, urged to join the pace three deep in the second furlong, pressed the issue to upper stretch and gave way. JR THE CREEPS settled into stride along the inside tracking the leaders but never seriously menaced. FAYREEN broke sharply to set the pace in the opening furlong, dueled for command inside foes racing into the bend but gave way early.
