SEATTLE GRUNGE came in at the break to tighten up several rivals to her outside, set the pace on a clear lead and drew off in the drive. DOWAGER LADY, in tight at the start, settled in early, angled out in upper stretch, was bumped by a rival, then rallied belatedly. MAYBE SNOW raced close up but could not go with the winner and lost the place late. WININ MANIA improved her position in the drive. LITTLE KATIE saved ground to no avail. MS INCA QUEEN was not a factor. SOLILOQUY bobbled at the start, came inward when righted contributing to the crowding and was never prominent. POISON BERRY was in tight and squeezed back at the start. A MONTH OF SUNDAYS, in tight at the start, lugged in to bump DOWAGER LADY in the stretch and tired. UBETCHA, crowded at the start, gave way after a half. AFTER A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE START, SEATTLE GRUNGE WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST AND PLACED TENTH. THE RIDER ABOARD A MONTH OF SUNDAYS LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST DOWAGER LADY ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH BUT IT WAS NOT ALLOWED.
