Footnotes

I'VE GOT A SECRET led the second flight to the backstretch racing a bit off the inside, angled to the rail to challenge after a half, dueled inside foes for command to upper stretch, shook clear and just held the challenge of FIRE CLOUD under pressure. The latter was held up three wide in second flight racing to the backstretch, bid three wide between foes for command on the far turn, closed the gap on the winner in the final sixteenth and just missed. SLEWZOOM tracked the pace between foes as part of the second flight, angled to the inside on the far turn to bid inside foes in upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. PULLMANITE, reserved off the inside in the opening half, was forced into the path of PALO DURO CANYON when losing his path to the winner after a half, altered course four wide to challenge in that path on the far turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. SO ON AND SO FORTH went up to dispute the pace inside a rival in the opening stages, dueled between foes for command on the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. PALO DURO CANYON was guided to the inside early to track the leaders unhurried, was jostled by a rival near the half mile marker and never menaced thereafter. FABLE'S FINALE angled inwards to prompt the pace outside a rival racing into the backstretch, then gave way entering the far turn.
