MY GAL was guided to the rail in the opening stages to save ground under light rating racing through the first turn while dropping well off the second flight, commenced a steady advance inside foes entering the far turn racing nearest the rail, shifted out three deep entering upper stretch while gaining terms with the first flight, switched inside ART OF DECEPTION approaching the furlong marker to challenge for command inside that rival, wrested command near the sixteenth marker and edged clear late under firm left handed encouragement. The latter broke readily to attend a rival's pace racing into the first turn, continued on her own courage three deep on the backstretch while dictating terms to her foes on a narrow margin, continued in that fashion into the far turn, steadily edged forward racing into upper stretch while shifting out a bit but couldn't contain the winner's final bid. HARD ROCK GIRL was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the first turn, continued with a steady effort pressing the issue along the rail through the far turn to upper stretch but weakened in late stages. IT'SALLABOUTRED broke slowly, was settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, angled out seven wide racing into upper stretch and continued with an effort to improve position. SO LONG JULIE, reserved off the second flight racing four deep in the opening stages, was urged to lodge a brief bid while racing five wide through the far turn but flattened out in upper stretch. ONEDAYATATYME shifted off the inside early while dropping off the second flight racing into the backstretch, continued in a wide trip to upper stretch and offered no rally. SLIGO BREEZE tracked off the

second flight three deep between foes racing into the backstretch and steadily faded while shifting out four, then five wide racing into the stretch. ZAP'EM was hustled along to secure a forward placing three, then four deep racing into the backstretch, continued under pressure entering the second bend to lodge a brief, four wide bid between foes but soon emptied out. WIN FRIENDLY shifted off the inside early while being held up just off the first flight, briefly prompted the leaders while in touch with the first flight racing into the backstretch but steadily retreated entering the second bend.
