TIDY UP raced unhurried along the rail tracking the first flight from just out of striking position in the opening half, came through inside foes to challenge for command nearing upper stretch, gained a clear advantage leaving the three sixteenths marker, then steadily widened his margin in the last furlong while being kept to firm encouragement. INVISIBLE STAR, unhurried in early stages while shifting nearer to the inside, continued between foes while steadily drawing into contention nearing the far turn, switched out four wide on the second bend while being roused to challenge, continued in that path into upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner but prevailed for place honors. STITCHNTWINE, caught five wide racing into the first turn while under some pressure to gain a contending position, dropped off the leaders racing outside foes on the backstretch, shifted out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued well enough to earn a share. QUIET REVOLUTION exchanged bumps with LORD AND T. at the start, was quickly righted to dispute the pace between foes racing into the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch. LORD AND T. exchanged bumps at the start, was urged to dispute the pace inside foes a bit off the rail racing into the far turn and emptied out nearing midstretch. GRACIAS DERENZO was settled in hand racing to the far turn and never seriously menaced. L. B. EXPRESS broke outwards, then shifted into the path of STITCHNTWINE racing four deep into the first turn while being urged to contention, dropped off the leaders after a half, was pulled up midway through the far turn and was vanned off the course.
