Footnotes

NUT 'N BUTTER secured a forward placing stalking just outside the pacesetter under some reserve in the opening stages, steadily increased the tempo racing into upper stretch, was roused to wrest command leaving the furlong marker and went clear late under firm encouragement. ROYAL POSH moved to the fore from between foes soon after the break, angled to the inside setting the pace, dueled for command racing into upper stretch, couldn't match the winner in the last furlong and just lasted for second. STARIANA tracked the leaders along the inside under rating from just out of striking distance in the opening quarter, saved ground to upper stretch, angled out nearing the furlong marker while making steady progress late and just missed second. I SEE MAMBO broke inwards brushing the gate, was steadied off ALINA'S SWEETEST, settled into stride while making her way nearer the inside and never menaced thereafter. LIGHT MY SAPHIRE switched outside foes in the opening stages while moving to a tracking position just outside the first flight, continued in that path into the turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. ALINA'S SWEETEST threw her head while ducking outwards at the start and soon dropped out.
