MASSECUITE was rated just off the leaders racing nearest the rail in the opening stages, continued unhurried tracking those foes into the second bend, shifted out three wide nearing the quarter mile marker while readily moving to striking position, was roused to wrest command and drew clear under firm left handed prompting. COURTESY TITLE was urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace racing into the first turn, attended that foe's tempo under light rating racing to the second bend, forced the issue racing into upper stretch, couldn't match terms when challenged by the winner but continued with interest under firm handling to edge a rival for place honors. JAYBIRD'S MIRACLE tracked just off the leaders outside a rival in the opening half, steadily drew into striking distance while angling out four wide racing into upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner and was outfinished for second. O'CONNELL'S (BRZ) settled in hand in the opening half, swung out to race five wide entering upper stretch and made some belated progress. MOLANDER was urged to the lead while angling to the inside racing into the first turn, dueled for command into the far turn, then was steadied a bit while shifting out and giving way once headed in upper stretch. MANDU GENIUS, reserved from out of striking distance racing off the inside in the opening half, couldn't produce the needed closing bid.
