Footnotes

ITS TRUE TYPE, brushed at the start, moved to the fore outside foes in the opening quarter, dictated the pace on a clear margin racing well off the rail through the turn and steadily widened her advantage under firm encouragement and some right handed taps. ZIPPY TRIP was held up just off the first flight in the opening stages, exchanged some contact with CLOSE CALL near the half mile marker while moving to striking position, shifted to the rail on the bend, continued willingly into the stretch while failing to gain terms with the leader but proved best of the others. MULTIPURPOSE raced unhurried off the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out on the turn while being urged to advance and continued evenly into the stretch to earn a share. CLOSE CALL broke outwards brushing the eventual winner, shifted in prompting that foe's pace racing into the turn, exchanged contact with ZIPPY TRIP after the opening quarter, continued near the inside into the bend and steadily weakened racing into the stretch. SAINT PATTY ANN settled into stride along the inside in early stages and never mounted a serious challenge. MS FOUREIGHTWONINE worked her way inside foes tracking off the second flight racing to the bend but lacked a closing response. CUEVO SPRINGS was settled outside a rival in the opening stages, shifted out nearing upper stretch but never seriously menaced.
