KENTUCKY GAL gained a position stalking just off and outside the first flight in the opening stages, moved to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch, continued in an extended skirmish with HAREM DANCER past midstretch then narrowly edged that foe on the wire under firm right handed prompting. The latter broke readily, attended a rival's pace in the first flight while between foes racing into the bend, was urged to gain a narrow advantage in upper stretch, then continued in an extended duel for command to the end while just failing to hold the winner. MICHALINA tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight in the opening quarter, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch to challenge, drifted out leaving midstretch while failing to match terms with the top pair but continued under pressure to edge a rival for a share. I SEE MAMBO, reserved in last while shifting out in early stages, was caught five wide racing through the turn advancing to contention, couldn't sustain a closing response and was carried out a bit in late stages while being outfinished for third.. EVERYBODY LIES tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, shifted five wide racing into upper stretch and faded leaving the furlong marker. SPECTACULOUS, off a step behind the leaders, was urged to dispute the pace inside foes after the opening sixteenth, dueled for command on the turn and gave way in upper stretch. SHARE THE JOY settled into stride near the inside early and never seriously menaced.
