Footnotes

NAUGHTY AND NICE was urged to secure a forward placing three deep racing just off the leaders in the opening quarter, moved to challenge in that path entering upper stretch while being brushed by FAITH'S FORTUNE, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and drew away late under firm encouragement. FAITH'S FORTUNE, urged to join the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes into upper stretch, drifted a bit making some contact with the eventual winner leaving the three sixteenths marker and couldn't match that foe in the last furlong while prevailing for place honors. SLAVIC PRINCESS, within striking distance in the opening stages, was held up just off the first flight racing into the bend while well off the inside, shifted four wide racing into upper stretch and continued evenly in late stages while earning a share. RASPBERRY JAM settled outside foes in the last flight early, then continued with an even effort racing into the stretch to improve her position three deep racing through the stretch. CYBERPHOBE settled between foes in the last flight early and never gained contention. ALLIE KITTEN sped to the fore to dispute the pace while shifting off the inside, dueled for command racing well off the rail into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. STIVERS SUPRISE dropped out of contention early.
