### Footnotes

MEDALQUEST, pinched back at the start, settled into stride dropping well off the second flight racing into the backstretch, was urged to advance racing into the far turn while switching off the inside, swung five wide while making a sweeping run to contention racing into upper stretch, wrested the advantage leaving the furlong marker and drew well clear late under pressure. SIR BOB tracked just off the first flight outside foes racing to the backstretch under some reserve, steadily drew into contention while shifting out four deep nearing upper stretch, was urged to challenge in that path between foes racing into upper stretch, couldn't match the winner's kick but edged a rival for place honors late. VIKING, in touch with the pacesetter attending that rival's pace between foes racing into the backstretch, pressed the issue while racing in close quarters through the far turn, gained the advantage racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain that momentum once headed by the winner. KEEP ON SHINING, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out six wide racing into upper stretch and gained some position late in an even effort. DOUBLEDOWN AGAIN, off slowly, pulled his way to contention tracking just off the first flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, continued between foes into the far turn but came up empty nearing upper stretch. WEALTH MANAGEMENT settled in last racing well off the inside in the opening half and never gained contention. PEGASUS'S BOY shifted inwards crossing the eventual winner's path at the start, gained a position three deep tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, lodged a brief bid in that path between foes on the far turn but quickly flattened out. DELUX DEELITE was urged to the lead along the inside racing to the backstretch, dueled for command inside foes racing into the far turn, was caught in close quarters nearing upper stretch and quickly gave way.
