Footnotes

MADMADSKILLZ tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance leading the second flight on a narrow margin racing three deep between foes while under light rating, advanced to striking distance on his own courage in that path between foes racing into upper stretch, gained the advantage nearing the furlong marker and was roused clear under firm left handed encouragement. BACKDOC, caught five deep tracking off the second flight in the opening stages, was urged to advance in that path midway through the turn, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to prevail for place honors. HOLY FEVER was urged to gain a position inside foes in the second flight in the opening quarter, advanced along the rail when presented an opening entering upper stretch to challenge for command but was outkicked by the top pair. RAIN RAY settled off the second flight along the inside racing into the bend, saved some ground on the turn, shifted out five wide nearing the furlong marker and continued with an effort to gain some position.

LAZYLOVIN tracked off the second flight four wide between foes in the opening quarter, advanced to lodge a brief bid in that path nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. MOSQUILLO, urged to gain a forward placing just outside the pacesetter in the opening stages, was urged to prompt that foe racing into the turn, pressed the issue between foes to midstretch and emptied out. SEA LION sprinted to the lead while angling to the inside, set the pace along the inside on the turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch but emptied out nearing the furlong marker. WINDY CITY LEAL settled into stride near the inside, saved ground on the turn but never gained contention. GIBBY'S TORNADO was settled outside a rival in the last flight racing to the turn and never mounted a serious challenge. STATE PARK was a brief factor three deep between foes tracking just off the second flight racing into the bend but dropped out racing into upper stretch.
