FIRST OF FEBRUARY joined the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, edged forward on his own courage after a half, steadily drew clear racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. STARIANA shifted out in the opening stages tracking the leaders unhurried from just out of striking distance, advanced to challenge four wide racing through the far turn, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. VERDANT, reserved in hand while racing in close quarters in the opening stages, settled in last along the inside to the far turn, came around foes racing into the stretch while being urged to advance, shifted inwards under pressure racing through the stretch and finished evenly late. SHESA TOUGH KITTY, forwardly placed stalking just off the first flight in the opening half, made a brief bid between foes racing into the far turn but quickly emptied out. ARRESTED BY DUFFY, reserved off the leaders while angling to the inside early, couldn't produce the needed late response. STEELA was urged to dispute the pace along the rail racing into the backstretch, couldn't match terms with the winner after a half and emptied out leaving far turn.
