THUNDERING HOOFS was urged to secure the lead along the rail after the opening furlong, forged clear midway through the bend and held sway to the end under firm hand urging. TELMA settled well off the field racing to the turn, angled six wide in upper stretch and produced her best stride late to prevail for place honors. POCANELLA broke outwards bumping SURFIN WAVE, angled to the rail tracking the leader in second flight racing into the bend and continued willingly inside foes to prevail for a share. COURTESY CALL, urged to contend racing four wide into the turn, couldn't gain terms with the winner and steadily weakened in late stages. SURFIN WAVE, bumped at the start, was righted to track off the second flight outside rivals racing into the bend and lacked a closing response. UNAPOLEGTIC was urged between foes in pursuit of the pacesetter racing into the turn and steadily faded in upper stretch. BOSS GIRL rated between foes just off the second flight in early stages, steadily retreated from contention on the turn.
