Footnotes

MISS LIVINGSTON broke outwards bumping MY KENTUCKY BREEZE soundly at the start, was collected to track off the second flight racing well off the inside to the backstretch, steadily drew into striking distance while shifting five wide on the far turn, moved to challenge for command midstretch and narrowly prevailed in the final stages under pressure. D FIFTY, caught four wide racing into the first turn tracking just off the leaders, continued with a steady bid in that path to challenge for command entering the second bend, gained a narrow advantage racing into the stretch while shifting to the inside, then resisted the winner's bid to the end but came up second best. WISEMANS FELICE was guided to the inside early to track the leaders in second flight, saved ground to upper stretch tracking the leaders and continued well enough to prevail for a share. LET'S TRY ANOTHER, held up off the first flight between foes racing into the first turn, exchanged some contact with ROSE OF ASCOT after entering the backstretch, was urged to challenge between foes racing into the the far turn but lacked the needed final kick. SPIRIT OF A NATION, reserved along the inside in the opening half, swung out six wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. EMILY OSTROSKI settled into stride along the inside in the opening stages, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch but had no closing bid. CHICA SILVER was urged to the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, dueled for command inside foes into the far turn and quickly emptied out. MY KENTUCKY BREEZE, forced out at the start, never gained contention. ROSE OF ASCOT was urged to contend between foes in the first flight racing to the backstretch, exchanged some contact with LET'S TRY ANOTHER near the five furlong marker continued between foes into the second bend and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. PUSHIN UP DAISY was urged to contend three deep between foes racing into the backstretch and emptied out early.
