DISTORTED GROOM joined the pace outside a rival in the opening furlong, pressed for command racing into the bend, shook clear midway through the turn while angling to the rail, then gamely held the challenge of WHAT DO YOU MEAN in the last furlong under steady pressure. The latter tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance three deep in the opening quarter, commenced a steady advance nearing upper stretch to draw on terms with the leaders approaching the furlong marker but couldn't quite best that foe. BETTER MAKE MONEY settled into stride near the inside racing to the bend, shifted out nearing upper stretch to split foes and edged a rival for a share while failing to menace the top pair. CALZONE tracked the pace outside foes racing three deep into the bend, never gained striking distance and was outfinished for third. HATFIELD was urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the outset but gave way midway through the turn.
