ALOT OF HONEY was urged to secure a narrow advantage while shifting a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin to the far turn, shifted out while being roused to widen his advantage in upper stretch and drew clear under firm right handed encouragement. CALL TO GLORY, reserved in hand well off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn gathering momentum, angled five wide racing into upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but prevailed for place honors. AIRTIGHT tracked just off the leaders along the rail under some reserve racing to the backstretch, came through inside the pacesetter to challenge that foe entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. LARKFLITE angled inwards to prompt the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, chased that foe between rivals on the far turn and weakened in the final quarter. CAST A COLD EYE, stoutly rated outside a rival in the second flight in the opening half, advanced to challenge three deep racing through the far turn but failed to sustain his momentum. MENTIROSO settled just off the inside early, switched outside foes to race five wide midway through the backstretch but dropped out of contention early.
